To minimize the environmental impact and take more responsibility to the earth we live, MEAN WELL hereby confirms, to date, based on the feedback from our suppliers indicates that our products shipping to the EU territory comply with the (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR) regulated by the European Union.

Scope of Compliance

This compliance declaration refers exclusively to the product-specific original primary packaging materials. Secondary and/or tertiary packaging materials utilized within the supply chain may vary depending on the mode of transport and are not always under our direct control; therefore, they are excluded from this compliance declaration.

Compliance with the Requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40

- **Essential Requirements:** The original primary packaging of the declared device complies with the essential requirements concerning composition, recyclability, reusability, and the minimization of environmental impact as defined in Regulation.
- **Heavy Metal Restrictions:** The concentration levels of heavy metals (lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium) in the packaging materials do not exceed the permitted threshold values specified in Article 5 of the Regulation.
- **Waste Management:** Measures have been implemented to support the reuse, recycling, and environmentally sound management of packaging waste in accordance with the obligations of the Regulation.
